

# Stainless Steel Sink Cleaning

## STAINLESS STEEL SINK CLEANING EXAMPLE: TEA STAINING

1. Below is an image of a well-used stainless steel sink with visible tea staining:



2. Tea staining can be stubborn, especially when combined with lime scale build up and if left to get to the extent of the above it may prove hard to remove with just soap and water. Below is a method which will help to remove any staining. We masked off an area of the bowl as shown below in our testing to help demonstrate the difference the cleaning makes:



3. We used the readily available "Pink Stuff" cleaning paste in our test.



Applying the paste to a cloth rub the sink following the direction of the grain in the steel:



4. Once thoroughly cleaned, rinse the sink well with cold water. The tea staining has now been removed. The below image shows the left-hand side which was cleaned compared to the right hand side which was masked off and not cleaned.



5. The final image below shows the full sink base cleaned, all the tea staining was removed:



If tea is left to build up in the sink, it can be a little stubborn but with a little elbow grease and the correct cleaning products it can be easily removed.
